1. What is this a picture of? Who lives here? What can you see in the picture? How do you think Jaz was feeling when visiting her Grandma and Grandad?
2. Grandad left Jaz a list of jobs to do. Do you ever have jobs to do at home? Let's make our own list of jobs. What kind of jobs need to be done at home? What kind of jobs need to be done in the classroom? Which jobs did Jaz like? Which jobs did Jaz not like?
3. Jaz collected eggs from the chicken coop. What did Grandad do with the eggs? What else does he sell in his farm shop? Have you ever been to a farm shop? What kind of things did you see there? How is it different to a supermarket?
4. Jaz cleaned up the pig's poo. What did she do with it? Why? Do you know anything else that can be used as a fertilizer?
5. Jaz fed Grandad's cows. What do the cows give Grandad? Products made from milk are called dairy products. Do you know any other dairy products? Dairy products have calcium in them. Do you know what calcium is good for?
6. Jaz watered Grandad's tomatoes. Do you know anybody who grows vegetables at home? What do they grow? What is the name of the glass house which people use for growing plants?
7. Has anybody ever been to a farm? Whose farm was it? Were there any animals on the farm? What kind of animals? Did you see the farmer doing any jobs on the farm? What kind of jobs? Were there any machines on the farm? What kind of machines?
